The Deepstack Charity Classic serves as the primary and essential fundraiser for the work of Congregation B’Nai Torah of Ormond Beach, Florida.

Beyond its primary mission, each year, the Tournament is also proud to assist an entire basket basket of outside charities.

This year, they will include:

Senior Support Services at Jewish Community Services of South Florida keeps seniors active, healthy and living in their own homes for as long as safe and appropriate. From locations throughout Miami-Dade County, JCS helps clients maintain their dignity and independence with diverse initiatives that include home care, personal emergency response systems, home-delivered meals, care management, adult day care and transportation services.

The Jacobson Family Food Pantry, a program of Ruth & Norman Rales Jewish Family Services, delivers non-perishable groceries, fresh fruits and vegetables, milk and challah every other week free of charge to people experiencing serious financial difficulties. The Pantry distributes over 125,000 pounds of food annually to residents of Boca Raton and Delray Beach.

“I Have A Dream” Foundation (locally in Miami) is the only not for profit in America that works with lower income children from Kindergarten with unbroken, year round support through College. Participants (“Dreamers”) have proven that just because one is born into poverty, does not mean that one cannot succeed, if only given the opportunity.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County enables all young people, especially those who need them most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring and responsible citizens. Their goal is to provide world-class Club experiences that assure success is within reach of every child who walks through their doors.

BSO's Community Support Urgent Needs Funding at the Broward Sheriff's Office is a small, but vital part of this group of committed public servants. The Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) is a full-service, nationally accredited public safety agency helping in the community with approximately 5,400 employees, including more than 2,800 certified deputies and more than 600 fire rescue professionals.
